GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Operate equipment and waste hauling vehicles as directed based on operational needs.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Drive equipment and waste hauling vehicles
- Perform pre-trip and post-trip inspections in accordance with FMCSR guidelines
- Maintain Hours of Service logs (when required) accurate and up to date
- Identify and ensure write-ups of defective equipment on trucks
- Check all load related paper work prior to movement of load to ensure completeness and accuracy including Manifests, Bill of Lading, Land Disposal Restriction forms, etc.
- Ensure proper placarding of waste hauling vehicle
- Ensure professional and safe operation of vehicles while on customer property and over the road
- Wash trucks internally when directed
- Wash truck/trailer exterior as needed
- Perform minor maintenance functions on trucks as needed while on the road
- Load and prepare equipment for upcoming jobs. Unload equipment upon arrival on the job. Re-load equipment upon completion of the job and unload equipment upon return to the shop. This includes lifting, carrying and pulling equipment of various size, shape and weight
- Operates earth moving equipment in accordance with skill level
- Drive any and all vehicles as needed including those with manual and automatic transmissions
- Inspect, use and maintain various personal protection equipment including chemical protective suits and respiratory protection equipment
- Work in a variety of environments including landfills, remediation project sites, chemical plants, hot and cold weather and noisy environments, etc.
- Responsible for his/her own on the job safety and work quality
- Support and comply with all components of Loss Preventions System (LPS)
- Regular and physical attendance is an essential function of this position
- Regular and reliable attendance is an essential function of this position
- These items are not meant to be exhaustive of responsibilities, duties or requirements. Additional tasks may be requested as needed to meet overall objectives of Terra

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL REQUIREMENTS

- Good math skills
- Experienced in the operation of Tractor-Trailers including roll- off trailers, van trailers, tankers, gravel train (doubles)
- Must be thoroughly familiar with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations
- Must be familiar with Hazardous Materials Transportation Regulations
- Must have completed a defensive driving course or demonstrate defensive driving skills
- Must be able to work with little guidance and supervision
- Clean driving record as determined by the Company's current auto insurance carrier
- Must possess Group A CDL with X and Air Brake endorsements for operation of Tractor-Trailers.
- Valid drivers license with clean driving record
- Valid CDL with endorsements and clean driving record

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must successfully complete a Respirator certification physical examination
- Must pass DOT physical for operation of commercial motor vehicles
- Must pass Hazardous Waste Operations physical as defined by 29CFR1910.120
- Able to wear a respirator
- Able to stand, sit and walk for long periods of time
- Able to bend at the waist to reach within 6" of the ground and reach overhead
- Able to climb ladders and stairs without difficulty
- Must have manual dexterity sufficient for use of small hand tools, handling of small parts (e.g. nuts/bolts), and working with hands at various positions (e.g. overhead, front, low)
- No medical condition or impairment which would place the employee at increased risk in the event of an exposure to chemical agents
- No psychological or physical impairments that may present a safety risk to the employee and co-workers
- Able to lift, carry, push and pull equipment weighing up to 100 lbs with another employee's assistance
- Must be able to work in extreme temperature conditions, in confined areas and at heights in excess of 30 feet
- Good vision and hearing
- Drug free
- Able to read, write, understand and speak English

- Truck Driving Certification or 2-5 years related experience
- Minimum of 1 year experience in industrial or environmental fuel
- High School Diploma or GED
